THE INTERNSHIP

Project Management Profile

We are looking for candidates who are highly organised, diligent, and are able to independently manage projects related to travel security. This profile will be assessing specific security-related projects within the scope of travel security, crisis handling, and stress management. This profile will manage projects as well as assist in preparing, executing, and evaluating training for our clients.
