- Private and charter flights may also use St. Gallen– Altenrhein Airport (ACH).


Approximate drive times

 1.5 hours (117 km / 73 mi)



- Chauffeured vehicle: flexibility, privacy and efficiency.



Inner security zone






Limited parking

8 QUESTIONS

WHEN CHOOSING YOUR DAVOS GROUND TRANSPORTATION PARTNER

1. Insurance coverage

Are vehicles and passengers fully and appropriately insured in Switzerland?

2. Regulatory compliance

Are your vehicles compliant with local licensing requirements?

3. Driver qualifications

Are the drivers experienced, multilingual, familiar with Davos and compliant with Swiss drive-rest regulations?

4. Operational readiness

Is your fleet based locally and equipped to operate effectively under WEF traffic restrictions and winter conditions?

5. Coordination

How are real-time coordination and communication managed during route changes or delays?

6. Flexibility

Can transportation be arranged only for selected days or trips, or must it be booked for the full duration of the event?

7. Contingency planning

Do you maintain backup vehicles and drivers in case of breakdowns, delays, or last-minute changes?

8. Health and hygiene

Are vehicles and drivers prepared to maintain elevated hygiene and sanitation standards during the winter and flu season?


